This tongue in cheek pastiche of a 1930s murder mystery opens with the voice of the murderer inviting the audience to follow the clues about to be presented as they will lead them to the identity of the murderer.

During the course of the evening, one of the dinner guests, Andreas Capadistriou, informs each of the guests that he has the means to blackmail them. Not surprisingly he meets a spectacularly sticky end but ... whodunnit?
