Is there a Geoffrey in the house?

A fantastic opportunity has arisen for a talented 40+ year old male actor to be part of Banbury Cross Players' 2015-2016 Season Opening production of Alan Ayckbourn's comedy *Absurd Person Singular*.

Set in three separate kitchens over three Christmases, the play follows the fortunes of three wildly incompatible couples charting the relentless rise of the socially aspiring *Hopcrofts* at the expense of two other couples.

Geoffrey Jackson is a confident, almost flashy, architect, something of a Jack-the-Lad and a serial womanizer. Initially on the way up, Geoffrey is destined to fall from grace after a building he designed collapses. By the third act, he is an utterly broken man: his confidence and charisma have been dashed by his career grinding to a halt.

This uproarious, agonisingly funny comedy is to be performed at The Mill Arts Centre, Banbury, 21-24 October 2015. Rehearsals are two nights a week with some Sunday afternoons.
